Professor John Skinner is a Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon at the Royal National Orthopaedic Hospital, Stanmore, UK. He is a hip and knee replacement surgeon and the Clinical lead for Joint Replacement and the Director of Research at Stanmore. In 2004 he was awarded the prestigious ABC Travelling Fellowship. He jointly established the London Implant Retrieval Centre in 2007, which has collected 8000 failed orthopaedic implants and has published 130 papers on this subject. He is Past President of the British Hip Society and is a member of the International Hip Society. He is the Honorary Treasurer of the BOA and sits on the Editorial Board of the Bone and Joint Journal.
